Poker Room Official Rules

1. Players are responsible for protecting his/her own hand.
2. Players cards must remain in plain view for everyone to see.
3. Only one player per hand is allowed.
4. All games are table stakes.
5. English only while at the table.
6. String bets are not allowed.
7. Check and raise are permitted.
8. One bet and four raises are allowed.
9. No Profanity or obscene language.
10. Tearing, Throwing, Bending, or Crumpling the cards is not allowed.
11. No form of cheating or collusion, this includes team play.
12. No smoking or vaping will be allowed in the poker room.
13. Cards speak for themselves.
14. All guests must turn over their own cards. The dealers are not allowed to do this.
15. The dealer will read the hands that have been turned over by the guest.
16. Verbal bets are binding.
17. All money put into the pot even if it is not that players turn stays in the pot.
18. No rabbit hunting. Asking the dealer to reveal what the next community card is.
19. Saracen poker room will not be responsible for any chips or cash left unattended on the tables.
20. Zero tolerance regarding abusive language and behavior towards guest and Saracen Resort Team Members.
21. Cell phones and other electronic devices may be used at the poker table when not in a hand, and or allowed on the rail.
22. Any player, dealer or floor person who sees an error about to be made in awarding a pot has an ethical obligation to speak up if the hand has been tabled.
23. If you cash out and return within two hours, you must buy back in for at least the amount you left with.
24. All decisions will be made in the fairness of the game. The floor decisions are final.

The following actions are improper, and grounds for warning, suspending, or barring a violator:

- Deliberately acting out of turn.
- Deliberately splashing chips into the pot.
- Agreeing to check a handout when a third player is all-in.
- Reading a hand for another player at the showdown before it has been placed face up on the table.
- Telling anyone to turn a hand face up at the showdown.
- Revealing the contents of a live hand in a multi handed pot before the betting is complete. Revealing the contents of a folded hand before the betting is complete. Do not divulge the contents of a hand



during a deal even to someone not in the pot, so you do not leave any possibility of the information being transmitted to an active player.

- Needlessly stalling the action of a game.
- Deliberately discarding hands away from the muck. Cards should be released in a low line of flight, at a moderate rate of speed (not at the dealer's hands or chip-rack).
- Stacking chips in a manner that interferes with dealing or viewing cards.
- Making statements or taking action that could unfairly influence the course of play, whether or not the offender is involved in the pot.

The interpretation of these rules, questions regarding eligibility to participate and any disputed issues not expressly covered by these rules will be resolved by the gaming facilities of the Saracen Development LLC. Management reserves the right to change, modify, suspend, or cancel this promotion at any time, for any reason without notice. By entering this promotion, each participant irrevocably agrees and acknowledges to be bound by the Official Rules; irrevocably waives all of his or her rights to bring any claim, action or proceeding against the gaming facilities of the Saracen Development LLC of the Quapaw Nation in connection with this promotion; and forever and irrevocably releases, indemnifies, and holds harmless the Saracen Development LLC of the Quapaw Nation, the gaming facilities of the Quapaw Nation, and its shareholders, officers, directors, employees, representatives, and agents from any liability and damages that may arise from, result from, or are in connection with the promotion, including but not limited to: (a) any promotion-related activity or element thereof; (b) any change in the prize due to unavailability or reasons beyond reasonable control, human error, any interruptions in or postponement, cancellation, or modification of the promotion. POKER ROOM SEATING & WAITLIST POLICY

To maintain balanced games and a positive experience for all players, Poker Room Management and Staff control all seating decisions, including table assignments, table changes, and filling open seats. These procedures help ensure fair access, game integrity, and a great poker experience for everyone. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

GENERAL WAITLIST PROCEDURES

- Players physically present and checked in at the poker podium receive priority waitlist seating.
- In-person waitlist players will be placed ahead of Bravo App or call-in waitlist players that have not physically checked in at the poker podium.
- Players may wait in the designated area or opt in for text notifications.
 - Players must arrive within 5 minutes of a sent text notification, or the seat may be filled.
 - A player may remain at the top of the list after the first missed call.
 - After two missed calls, a player will be removed from that game's list.
- Call-in's on the waitlist not physically checked-in will be removed from the waitlist after 1.5 hours.
- Missed calls, early check-ins, or attempts to bypass procedures may result in **loss of seating priority**.

ROOM OPENING & CALL-IN WAITLIST

To ensure fair play, smooth operations, and the integrity of promotional offers:

- Players may add their name to the Bravo Call-in Waitlist list up to 1.5 hours prior to the poker room's scheduled opening.
 - Players who add their name to the waitlist earlier than 1.5 hours before opening will be removed from the call-in list.
- Physical check-ins will not be accepted until 15 minutes prior to opening for any game with an active promotion.
 - Physical check-ins are seated/added to list on a first-come, first-served basis immediately after the Bravo App/call-ins who are physically present 15 min prior to schedule game start have been checked in.
 - Management reserves the right to begin general play on any game prior to scheduled promotion start upon room opening once enough players have checked in.

SEAT SELECTION & MOVEMENT

- No Seat Hopping: Players may not choose or change seats without staff approval.



- Forced Moves (“Must-Moves”): Management may require players to move to balance tables or maintain game viability.

New Games: In newly opened games, the first player to arrive generally receives first seat selection.
