



## **Sunday Tournament Rules**

1. The Saracen Poker Room guarantees a minimum prize pool of \$1,500, provided at least nine (9) players register within the first ten (10) minutes of the tournament.
2. Tournament registration closes at the end of the first break.
3. Players eliminated from the tournament may re-enter until the end of the first break.
4. All blind levels are twenty (20) minutes in duration.
5. The tournament buy-in is \$75, allocated as follows: \$48 to the prize pool, \$14 as an administrative fee, \$3 to the promotional fund, and \$10 to staff fees.
6. Each entry begins with \$20,000 in tournament chips. Re-entries are permitted until the conclusion of the first scheduled break.
7. Each entry is eligible for one (1) \$25 add-on, which provides an additional \$10,000 tournament chips until registration is closed.
8. In the event of an overlay, the shortfall will be funded by the promotional fund.
9. All tournaments are governed by Tournament Directors Association (TDA) rules, unless otherwise specified. House rules shall take precedence in the event of any conflict.
10. Players must sign up for any promotional funds and tournament winnings received.



## **Monday & Thursday Tournament Rules**

1. The Saracen Poker Room guarantees a minimum prize pool of \$1,000, provided at least nine (9) players register within the first ten (10) minutes of the tournament.
2. Tournament registration closes at the end of the first break.
3. Players eliminated from the tournament may re-enter until the end of the first break.
4. All blind levels are twenty (20) minutes in duration.
5. The tournament buy-in is \$60, allocated as follows: \$37 to the prize pool, \$10 as an administrative fee, \$3 to the promotional fund, and \$10 to staff fees.
6. Each entry begins with \$20,000 in tournament chips. Re-entries are permitted until the conclusion of the first scheduled break.
7. Each entry is eligible for one (1) \$25 add-on, which provides an additional \$10,000 tournament chips.
8. Players who participate in live-action poker from Thursday from 12:00 PM through 5:00 PM on the day of the tournament will receive \$2,000 in tournament chips for each full hour played.
9. In the event of an overlay, the shortfall will be funded by the promotional fund.
10. All tournaments are governed by Tournament Directors Association (TDA) rules, unless otherwise specified. House rules shall take precedence in the event of any conflict.
11. Players must sign up for any promotional funds and tournament winnings received.



## **Friday Tournament Rules**

1. The Saracen Poker Room guarantees a minimum prize pool of \$2,000, provided at least nine (9) players register within the first ten (10) minutes of the tournament.
2. Tournament registration closes at the end of the first break.
3. Players eliminated from the tournament may re-enter until the end of the first break.
4. All blind levels are twenty (20) minutes in duration.
5. The tournament buy-in is \$100, allocated as follows: \$75 to the prize pool, \$12 as an administrative fee, \$3 to the promotional fund, and \$10 to staff fees.
6. Each entry begins with \$20,000 in tournament chips. Re-entries are permitted until the conclusion of the first scheduled break.
7. Each entry is eligible for one (1) \$25 add-on, which provides an additional \$10,000 tournament chips.
8. In the event of an overlay, the shortfall will be funded by the promotional fund.
9. All tournaments are governed by Tournament Directors Association (TDA) rules, unless otherwise specified. House rules shall take precedence in the event of any conflict.
10. Players must sign up for any promotional funds and tournament winnings received.



## **\$10K GTD Tournament Rules**

1. The Saracen Poker Room guarantees a minimum prize pool of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), provided a minimum of nine (9) players are registered and seated within the first ten (10) minutes of tournament start time.
2. Tournament registration shall remain open until the commencement of Level 9 for all starting flights (Flights A, B, and C).
3. The tournament buy-in is one hundred sixty dollars (\$160), allocated as follows: one hundred twenty-three dollars (\$123) to the prize pool, twenty-two dollars (\$22) as an administrative fee, twelve dollars (\$12) as a staff fee, and three dollars (\$3) to the Poker Promotional Fund.
4. Each registered participant shall begin tournament play with thirty thousand (30,000) tournament chips.
5. Eliminated players may re-enter the same flight or another available flight at any time prior to the start of Level 9.
6. Players eliminated on any starting flight day may re-enter on any subsequent starting flight. Players who did not participate in an earlier flight are eligible to enter any later flight.
7. Tournament levels shall be structured as follows: All Levels for this tournament will be 25 minutes.
8. Flights 1A, 1B, and 1C shall continue until either fifteen percent (15%) of the original field remains, or the completion of Level 16, whichever occurs first. On Sunday, play shall resume at the lowest completed level among Flights 1A, 1B, or 1C.
9. All players advancing from Flights 1A, 1B, and 1C must return by 12:00 PM on Sunday. Tournament play shall continue until a single winner is determined.
10. This tournament includes bagging and multiple-bagging features. If a player qualifies bag chips in two (2) flights, the smallest chip bag must be repurchased for five hundred dollars (\$500). If a player qualifies to bag chips in all three (3) flights, the two (2) smallest chip bags must be repurchased for a total of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500).
11. All Bag Buy Back funds shall be considered as part of the tournament prize pool.
12. In the event of an overlay, any guaranteed prize pool shortfall shall be funded by the Poker Promotional Fund in accordance with approved internal controls.
13. This tournament shall be governed by the Tournament Directors Association (TDA) Rules, unless otherwise stated. In the event of a conflict, Saracen Poker Room house rules shall prevail.
14. All players are required to sign appropriate documentation acknowledging receipt of any tournament winnings or promotional funds.



## **\$50K GTD Tournament Rules**

1. The Saracen Poker Room guarantees a minimum prize pool of Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), provided a minimum of nine (9) players are registered and seated within the first ten (10) minutes of tournament start time.
2. Tournament registration shall remain open until the commencement of Level 9 for all starting flights (Flights A, B, C and D).
3. The tournament buy-in is one hundred sixty dollars (\$350), allocated as follows: one hundred twenty-three dollars (\$300) to the prize pool, twenty-two dollars (\$27) as an administrative fee, twelve dollars (\$22) as a staff fee, and three dollars (\$3) to the Poker Promotional Fund.
4. Each registered participant shall begin tournament play with thirty thousand (30,000) tournament chips.
5. Eliminated players may re-enter the same flight or another available flight at any time prior to the start of Level 9.
6. Players eliminated on any starting flight day may re-enter on any subsequent starting flight. Players who did not participate in an earlier flight are eligible to enter any later flight.
7. Tournament levels shall be structured as follows: Levels 1 through 16 shall be Thirty (30) minutes in duration; Levels 17 and higher shall be Forty-Five (45) minutes in duration.
8. Flights 1A, 1B, 1C and 1D shall continue until either fifteen percent (15%) of the original field remains, or the completion of Level 16, whichever occurs first. On Sunday, play shall resume at the lowest completed level among Flights 1A, 1B, 1C or 1D.
9. All players advancing from Flights 1A, 1B, 1C and 1D must return by 12:00 PM on Sunday. Tournament play shall continue until a single winner is determined.
10. This tournament includes bagging and multiple bagging features. If a player qualifies to bag chips in two (2) flights, the smallest chip bag must be repurchased for One Thousand dollars (\$1000). If a player qualifies to bag chips in Three (3) flights, the two (2) smallest chip bags must be repurchased for a total of Three thousand dollars (\$3,000). If a player qualifies to bag chips in all Four (4) flights, the Three (3) smallest chip bags must be repurchased for a total of Five thousand dollars (\$5,000)
11. All Bag Buy Back funds shall be considered as part of the tournament prize pool.
12. In the event of an overlay, any guaranteed prize pool shortfall shall be funded by the Poker Promotional Fund in accordance with approved internal controls.
13. This tournament shall be governed by the Tournament Directors Association (TDA) Rules, unless otherwise stated. In the event of a conflict, Saracen Poker Room house rules shall prevail.
14. All players are required to sign appropriate documentation acknowledging receipt of any tournament winnings or promotional funds.
